**OPENING COMMENTS/
WALL OF FAME
RECOGNITION** Dave Long was recognized for his many contributions to the Lompoc Unified School District. Mr. Long served with distinction for 40 years, as a teacher and coach, including 15 years as the founder and Executive Director of the Cabrillo High School Aquarium.

CONSENT ITEMS The following consent items were approved: (1) Warrants totaling \$508,136.44; (2) Acceptance of Donations; (3) Personnel Items as Recommended; (4) Declaration of Surplus Property from Lompoc High School, and (5) Declaration of Surplus Property from La Cañada and Los Berros Elementary Schools.

STUDENT REPORT Daniel Rogers, alternate student representative for Cabrillo High School, gave a report regarding activities at the secondary schools.

**AWARD OF CHANGE
ORDERS** The Board approved all the change orders in a single motion after discussion. Approved were #'s 25, 26 and 27 for Lompoc High School, #'s 15 and 16 for Lompoc Valley Middle School, and #'s 7 and 8 for La Cañada, Clarence Ruth and Fillmore. All were for modernization at the sites.

**RESOLUTION:
K-3 CLASS SIZE
REDUCTION** A resolution was adopted by the Board which formally states that the District will participate in the K-3 Class Size Reduction Program in order to receive the funding.

**DISTRICT PROPOSAL
TO LFT** The Board adopted the District's initial proposal to the Lompoc Federation of Teachers (LFT) for negotiations in the 2007-2008 school year.

**DISTRICT PROPOSAL
TO CSEA** The Board adopted the District's initial proposal to the California School Employees Association (CSEA) for negotiations in the 2007-2008 school year.

**APPROVAL OF
SCHOOL PLANS** The 2007 - 2008 school plans for Crestview Elementary, and Cabrillo and Maple High Schools were approved.

**SCHOOL SAFETY
PLANS (APPROVAL)** The Board approved the safe school plans for Lompoc Valley, El Camino and Vandenberg Middle Schools; and Buena Vista Elementary School.

**TEXTBOOK
ADOPTIONS** The Board approved the adoption of a horticulture textbook for Vandenberg Middle School, and life science and physical science textbooks for 7th and 8th graders at El Camino, Lompoc Valley and Vandenberg Middle Schools.

**SIXTH GRADE
TRANSITION** The Board approved moving the 2008-2009 sixth graders from Los Padres to Crestview Elementary. The students will be placed in portable classrooms.
