Student And Family Privacy Rights

The Governing Board believes that personal information concerning district students and their families should be kept private in accordance with law. (cf. 0000 - Vision) (cf. 0100 - Philosophy) (cf. 0200 - Goals for the School District) (cf. 5020 - Parent Rights and Responsibilities) (cf. 5021 - Noncustodial Parents) (cf. 5125 - Student Records) (cf. 5125.1 - Release of Directory Information) (cf. 6000 - Concepts and Roles) (cf. 6162.8 - Research)

The Superintendent or designee shall consult with parents/guardians regarding the development and adoption of this policy.

**Collection of Personal Information for Marketing Purposes**

The Board prohibits district staff from administering or distributing to students survey instruments that are designed for the purpose of collecting personal information for marketing or for selling that information.
