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### **CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE APPLICATIONS ARE AVAILABLE**

Lompoc Unified School District (the "District") passed a general obligation bond, "Measure N," on November 5, 2002. As a result of the Proposition 39 Bond Election, the Board of Trustees of the Lompoc Unified School District was required to establish an independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (the "Committee").

There are two (2) "mandatory" membership positions to be filled. One position on this seven person Committee is vacant due to the recent relocation of the member who was the parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District. The member's two-year term began on July 1, 2009 and will end on June 30, 2011. The second membership opening is for an individual who is active in a business organization representing a business community located within the Lompoc Unified School District. This membership term would be from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2011.

Each membership is for a term of two (2) years, and no member may serve more than two consecutive terms.

The District is soliciting applications from individuals to serve as members. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and reside within the District's geographic boundary. The Committee may not include any employee, official of the District, or any vendor, contractor or consultant of the District.

Applications, as well as a copy of the Bylaws approved by the Board of Trustees to govern the activities of the Committee, are available in the office of Gregory Kampf, Lompoc Unified School District Superintendent of Schools, at 1301 North "A" Street. Deadline for receipt of applications is 4:00 p.m. on March 5, 2010.
