## Senior Information 2018

- Caps and Gowns
  - Will be distributed today. Please read and adhere to the Dress Code expectations for graduation.
  - If you have not paid for your gown in full you will not be able to pick it up. Once you pay the balance you can have it.
  
- Senior Enrichment
  - Monday, May 21 – attend first period then report to the east parking lot (by stadium) by 9:00 a.m.
  - Spend the day at the Mustang Water Park, 6850 Lopez Drive, Arroyo Grande.
  - Cost is only \$5 but you must buy a ticket to be placed on the dismissal list
  - You must be debt free – turn in library books and clear other debts before you buy!
  - Sales begin Monday, April 20 – May 18 – **NO EXCEPTIONS - NO CHECKS CASH ONLY!**
  - If you do not attend Senior Enrichment Day, you must attend school or your absence **WILL NOT BE EXCUSED.**
  - You must have a **CURRENT** school ID to purchase your Senior Enrichment Day Ticket.
  - You must bring your **SIGNED** boarding pass and current school ID to board the bus on Monday, May 21. **PLEASE DO NOT FORGET YOUR SIGNED BOARDING PASS!!!**
  
- Grad Nite
  - Sales began, April, 20 – May 7, 2018. Must have signed permission slip
  - Sales for guests of seniors w/approved guest pass and permission slip.
  - **ALL GRAD NITE SALES END ON ~~FRIDAY~~, MAY 7th** (Or earlier if we sell out.)

  - **PRICES FOR SENIORS \$105 & GUEST \$115. CASH ONLY – NO REFUNDS!**

- You must have a signed parent permission slip before purchasing a Grad Nite ticket. Guests must have a guest pass AND a parent permission slip. Permission slips are available in the Activities office. **You must show your current school ID to purchase a ticket.**
- Magic Mountain is very strict about dress code and items brought into Magic Mountain so be sure to check the rules before leaving home.
- Graduation Practice
  - Wednesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. **THIS IS MANDATORY!!**
  - Report to the gym
  - You must stay the entire time
  - Just wear normal clothes – not your cap and gown
  - We will go through the entire graduation ceremony so you know what you are doing.
- Graduation
  - Thursday, June 7<sup>th</sup> – Seniors are not required to attend school that day
  - Report to the gym at 1:00 in your cap and gown – be careful of your tassel – it can easily blow off or fall on the way to the gym – you will not be able to replace your lost tassel the day of graduation.
  - Be ready to be searched
  - Dress code:
    - Shirt with collar and tie, dress pants, socks, dress shoes for guys
    - Dress, dressy skirt, dress pants and blouse, dress shoes or sandals for girls
    - No flip flops, no tennis shoes, jeans, shorts, tee shirts, bar midriiffs, etc. for anyone
  - You will not be allowed to carry anything into the graduation ceremony: cell phones, keys, purses, flowers, balloons, bags, etc.
  - Caps and gowns must be worn as delivered.
  - Girls – choose your heels carefully as you will be walking on grass and do not want to sink in.
